The Liberal Arts Leadership Scholarship is awarded by the COLA Dean’s Advisory Board to reward students in the college who are engaged in leadership activities. For the 2008-09 academic year, four students were awarded a total of \$7,000. For the 2009-2010 academic year, funds may be distributed among multiple scholarship recipients with individual scholarships typically ranging from \$1,000-\$2,500 each.

Application Requirements:

- Be a degree-seeking student in the College of Liberal Arts as of Winter 2009, full- or part-time, undergraduate or graduate.
- Have a minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA at the beginning of Winter 2009.
- Submit a 2-4 page essay (**double-spaced, 12 pt type**) clearly describing your **leadership activities and career goals** and the level/impact of those activities (university or community related) and how receiving this scholarship will assist in achieving your goals.
- Submit a separate paragraph which describes your financial need. The paragraph should include scholarships and/or financial aid you will be receiving or for which you have applied.
- Submit three letters of recommendation from non-family members (employers, teachers or faculty, coaches, etc.) that focus on leadership ability.
- Have not applied for the Liberal Arts Study Abroad Scholarship for the 2009/2010 year.

The committee reserves the right to exclude applications that do not meet these requirements.
